

Thank you for your interest in the Regional Ultreya to be held at Coventry Cathedral on Saturday 11th March from 10am until 12 noon. An exciting programme has been planned and the Cathedral is such an inspiring place and I'm sure you will be refreshed by the worship and fellowship there. The format will be similar to that of a Diocesan Ultreya: including Group Reunion; a witness talk and gospel response and of course a bit of rousing Cursillo singing. There may also be a closing Eucharist but this is yet to be confirmed.

Getting there

Located in the heart of Coventry, finding the Cathedral could not be easier! It is a 10-15 minute walk or 5 minute taxi ride from the railway station, and about 100 metres from the main Bus Station.

The main entrance to the Cathedral can be found off Priory Street opposite Coventry University or via St Michael's Avenue from the City Centre.

Visitors arriving by car can use Cox Street car park, located underneath the ring road (Sat Nav CV1 5GA). The Cathedral is less than 5 mins walk from there. This is a pay on exit car park and the cost of parking on a Saturday is currently:

£2 for 2-3 hours,
£2.50 for 3-4 hours,
£3 for 4-5 hours
£6 for 5-6 hours
£10 for over 6 hours

Refreshments

As we will be finishing around lunchtime you may want to have lunch in the 1940's themed Rising Café, (located at the north-west corner of the Cathedral) They serve a wide range of main meals, cakes, hot and cold drinks, afternoon tea, and speciality dishes. Rising does get quite busy, so please call 02476 521235 to enquire about booking. I can personally recommend the scones but the cakes looked really yummy too! (Well something had to be sampled in the name of research.)

For light bites a selection of hot and cold drinks, cakes, biscuits and sweets can also be purchased from Fairtrade, located within the Cathedral Shop on St Michael's Avenue.

Alternatively it is only a short walk to the main shops of Coventry City Centre
